  area needs to address public safety and homeless issues, setting the

- Keep our neighborhoods safe with a constant focus on public safety and innovative strategies that ensure all our resources are working together. I will continue to work closely with law enforcement to ensure our residents are informed, through crime watch discussions, community meetings and regular updates.
- Continue our commitment to our parks, trails and community beautification. Building on the work we have done for years to improve our parks, connect our trails and improve the landscape within D10, I will focus on engaging our community to embrace, enjoy and continue to improve our area's outdoor resources
